Moving from one room to the next in your home might seem like nothing to you, but for children with disabilities this task is be daunting.

South Florida resident, **Bill Forster**, saw a need to provide children with disabilities wheelchairs using his foundation to create what he calls a **Miracle Mission**. The Mission is made up of several organizations forming a partnerships of Messianic Jews, Christians and Jews working together in support of Israel. Some of the wonderful organizations that help to make this happen are Harvest of Israel, Hope Haven, Beth Yeshua Congregation, and the Joseph Project. The Foundation and its Miracle Mission partners provide individually fitted wheelchairs to challenged children of all faiths in Israel.

A wheelchair can transform the lives of children. The simplest of wheelchairs are in fact a luxury which many people in dire situations or poverty-stricken nations may never see. Give a person in that situation a wheelchair, and you not only provide mobility, but you also provide hope, dignity and opportunity.

FORSTER FOUNDATION'S MIRACLE MISSION is to provide disabled Israeli children of all faiths, wheelchairs fitted to meet their individual needs. The chairs are adjustable to meet their challenges for several years as they grow and develop. This life-changing gift enables each child to reach their full potential and provides them with hope, independence, mobility and self-esteem.

This is made possible by generous donations provided by Rabbi Greg Hershberg, Beth Yeshua Congregation and their several thousand followers, and the Forster Foundation and its donors, which provide 100% of all funding for our wheelchair mission.

These are brand new chairs, all fitted and adjustable to meet the unique needs of each child for several years as they grow. To date they have delivered 358 wheelchairs since the first Miracle Mission in April of 2018. The current goal is to reach donations which will enable the Foundation and its partners to deliver 300 wheelchairs currently on request.
